YOUR APPLICATION – NEXT STEPS

The Academy will contact you by email within one week of receiving your completed Application Form. The email will provide details about the next stage of the application process: your interview and portfolio presentation. The following guide will help you prepare.

Interview

Your interview will cover a range of topics and is designed to establish your suitability for higher education study and your interest in art and design. You should think of it as your opportunity to present the strongest case for yourself as a budding future designer or artist.

Be prepared to talk about:

- previous or current academic endeavours, especially subjects or certificate courses relevant to the course you are applying for
(eg, VCE subjects might include Visual Communication Design, Art, Studio Arts, Media, VET Applied Fashion Design & Technology, Product Design & Technology, Interactive Digital Media).
- relevant employment or experience that contributed to your interest in design
(eg, Where did you work? What was the nature of the work? How long were you in the role?)
- understanding and attitudes to design
(eg, Is there a designer whose work you admire? Why? What are some major issues concerning designers today?)
- individual qualities and attributes
(eg, Do you work better alone or as part of a group? Are you driven more by emotion or by intellect? Are you a 'big picture' person or more interested in detail and precision?)

You are also encouraged to raise any questions you might have about the course structure, content or other details.

As well as your portfolio (see below) we ask that you bring any relevant transcripts of academic results, if available. The Academy also reserves the right to request details of referees who can comment on your capacity for creative work, your potential to study independently at a tertiary level, etc.

If you are unable to attend an interview in person, you will be instructed to contact the Academy to reschedule or to arrange a 'remote' interview by phone or Skype.

Portfolio

All applicants must provide a portfolio of their own work. The Academy does not specify exactly what you should include in your portfolio as we recognise that portfolios should express your creativity and reflect your individuality.

Your portfolio should however include some finished pieces which demonstrate some relevance to the major study you are applying for. It is also good to show some development work. In the case where pieces are too big or cumbersome to bring along, good quality photographs are appropriate.

While most students bring printed works (including photos, drawings and paintings), some bring 3-dimensional items, clothing or videos. All media are acceptable, so long as they demonstrate creativity and relevance to the area you wish to study.

If you will be bringing an electronic portfolio please bring your own laptop or iPad to display it on.

If you are unable to attend an interview in person, you will need to provide at least six images from your portfolio prior to your phone/Skype interview. You may mail the images as photographs, prints or digital files on CD/DVD; or send them as a link to a file transfer website (eg WeTransfer, Hightail) or as an email attachment to admissions@academyofdesign.edu.au
